


THE “KELLISON STICKS”

A method of measuring proper visual distance from a foreground miniature to its live action component to ensure that the apparent scale of the miniature matches the scale of the background elements.

The markings on each stick are to scale with one another and when the heights and units of measurement on the sticks match each other visually (from the camera's P.O.V.), the scale and distance between the miniature and live action elements is correct for the shot.



When small stick with 1 inch marks matches full size stick with 1 foot marks then model is at correct distance from camera and in proper forced scale.
